REPORT

RE: Humanitarian aid in 2004

Andrea Charitable Foundation has been functioning in the Republic of Moldova for five years. During this period \$ 88.990 US have been transferred to its account through Children's Help Net Foundation. Andrea Foundation has taken part in all the activities held in the city of Chisinau, such as Invalid Day, Child's Day of June 1, Christmas Caravan in December, etc. Annually, on Easter holidays we visit older people at the Old Age Home to make them happy with Easter cakes and juice (at a sum of 5200US). We also transfer money to the ARIS DOWN agency to buy food for the children suffering from mongolism.

At the request of the children's Homes (Municipal and Republican^ along with food products, medicaments, vitamins, polivitamins, we pay for children's footwear, clothes, blankets, detergents, shampoo, construction materials (linoleum), etc.

This year, we have spent \$ 8,575 US to buy food, medicaments, vitamins, polyvitamins for the children placed with the Munici- pal Special Children's Orphanage.

In addition, to continuously supply heat to the Municipal Orphanage, especially, during the fall/winter period and not depend on the city central heating system, a project involving installation of the autonomous heating is being carried out. According to Contract No 32 of November 8, 2004 , \$3,000 US were transferred to the account of the Orphanage to buy two natural gas meters. According to Contract No 41 of November 8, 2004, a prepay was made, which makes 60% \$ 13,140 US) of the total cost, and the remaining 40% (\$8,760 US) will be paid after the equipment is delivered. The total cost of the autonomous heating system makes \$24,900 US. The total amount of the humanitarian aid provided to the Municipal Special Children's Orphanage makes \$ 33,475 US.

\$4,559 US have been spent to buy fruit, juice, shampoo, soap, detergents, children's footwear and clothing for the Young Children Placement and Rehabilitation Center. According to Contract No -12 of June 14, 2004, \$ 20,000 US were transferred to the account of the Placement Center to make repairs in the laundry area. Normal conditions of washing, drying, ironing, and keeping of children's linnen have been created.

\$600.00 US were spent to purchase gifts for Easter, Child's Day (June •I), Christmas Caravan presented, to the children cared by ARIS DOWN.

\$600.00US were transferred to the Municipal Directorate of Children's -Rights Protection to purchase gifts for the children placed with 'boarding schools, homeless children and those from families in need for Child's Day (June 1).

Andrea Charitable Foundation bought some items for the computer in 2004,

including a scanner for 57.00 US (Payment Order No 55 of September 21, 2004), a cartridge for the printer for \$8.00 US (Payment Order No 398081, Riscom, September 1, 2004), an adaptor to the digital camera for \$25.00 US, a net filter to stabilize voltage for \$5.00 US (Invoice 397205 of August 24, 2004). The total sum makes \$99.00 US.

During five years of its existence, Andrea Charitable Foundation have provided humanitarian aid to the children in need. Thus, the child, Costel Godjievski was operated on his brain due to our financial support; a deaf aid was presented to Ecaterina Trifonov who comes from a deaf-mute family, who is now happy for being able to hear the teachers at school.

The contribution to supporting children in need is made with love and warmth for the vulnerable part of the society who most need this financial, physical and emotional assistance.

We express you a profound gratitude for your long, permanent aid to the orphaned children placed with the children's homes in need of food, medicaments, vitamins, polyvitamins, as well as other things. You make the children happy when they get gifts on holidays. Due to you, Andrea Charitable Foundation is able to take part in all the charitable activities held in the city. Thanks a lot for your kindness and good and generous heart.

God save you, your family and the children adopted by you in Moldova who are growing to become worthy adults due to parental care and love.
